

MARKET FLASH - POLAND

- Poland's qualities as an investment location tend to be highly assessed by a number of reports published by the world's leading consulting firms. Recently published studies and reports indicate that Poland is considered one of the European leaders in terms of foreign investments.
- Polish Maritime Economy in 2013 & 2014 continued its' development as an important sector of national economy. Polish shipyards are involved in the national re-armament and Navy modernization programmes.
- Strategic programmes conducted by the Polish seaports, aimed at complex improvement of their competitive strength by improving both the infrastructure and the services. As a consequence of deep structural modernization, Polish ports - which are within the core of European TEN-T network - have experienced significant growth in 2013, particularly visible in volume of operations in container terminals (over 1,65 mln TEU, which is more than volume of similar operations in ports of Sweden and Finland). This growth was possible particularly due to the improved intermodal transport of containers further inland, of which approx. 30-40% is by railway. The existing infrastructure still leaves place for improvement in this respect. Further development within the LNG management (transport, refueling, bunkering facilities) is also expected due to the planned launch of gas-terminal in Świnoujście.
- Apart from the planned and agreed (for about 2,2 GW) offshore wind power plants within Polish territorial waters, numerous Polish companies are involved in offshore activity, both as investors developing their activity also abroad and as suppliers and contractors for drilling rigs and offshore power plants. Some of the Polish shipyards developed their own designs of OSV's, including the specialized vessels for offshore wind power plants construction.
